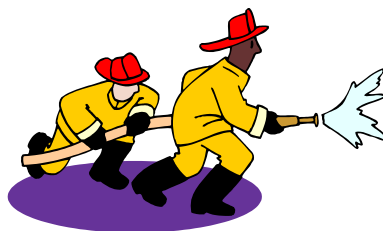


Toddler 1 NEWS
